NOTES: Passengers are authorized two pieces of baggage up to 70 lbs. each. Mobility assist equipment (to include powered wheelchairs) weighing over 100 lbs., and footwear such as five-toe-shoes, sandals, flip-flops, crocs, high heels, etc. are prohibited on flights. Infants under 6 weeks old, and persons beyond 34th week of gestation or less than 6 weeks post-partum must be certified in writing by a responsible physician as healthy to fly. Some locations have limited support capability, travelers must ensure availability of transportation and lodging at their next location. Travelers shall have sufficient personal funds to pay for commercial transportation. The DoD is not obligated to continue an individual's travel or return to point of origin.
