## **Tuition Reimbursement Program** State Program

- Based on the tuition rates of the University of Minnesota
- Current maximum reimbursement per **Fiscal Year** (Jul-Jun) is: **Undergrad \$17,000, and Graduate \$36,000** (Fees like parking, university, lodging and other student fees are not reimbursed)
- A total of **144** semester hour credits may be reimbursed towards an Associate, Baccalaureate, or Master's degree.
- Student must earn a grade of "**C**" or better for undergrad, and "**B**" or better in graduate work for tuition to be reimbursed.

## **Montgomery GI Bill** Federal Program

The Chapter 1606 GI Bill program is an entitlement, not a bonus, for a six-year enlistment. The benefits are available for 36 months of schooling at a VA accredited institution. The GI Bill can be used in conjunction with the Tuition Reimbursement Program.

## What should I bring to MEPS?

- Driver's License or State ID, Soc. Sec. Card, and [Request for Exam Form](#)
- An overnight bag if you're staying at the hotel (change of clothes, tooth brush etc)

## MEPS HAS A DRESS CODE \*\*\*\*If you break it, you will be sent home!\*\*\*\*

- **FLIP FLOPS/SANDALS ARE NOT ALLOWED** - Closed-toe shoes **AND SOCKS** are required
- Clean, appropriate **undergarments** are mandatory. You cannot physical without them. No lace, no thongs.
- You should wear seasonal attire of suitable appearance. Hats, headbands, sleeveless shirts, net shirts, tank tops, midriff or halter-tops, see-through clothing, swimwear and clothing with objectionable or obscene words or graphics are prohibited. ***Clothing with holes is NOT allowed.***
- Glasses: Applicants who require corrective lenses should report with glasses rather than contact lenses whenever possible. Note: Colored lenses are not acceptable for the color vision test. If you do bring contact lenses, ensure you bring the case and solution.
- ***CLEAN YOUR EARS BEFORE GOING TO MEPS!!!!*** They disqualify for excess wax build-up.
- **Remove all piercings and nail polish** - both on fingers and toes; no acrylic, gel, or fake nails are allowed when processing MEPS.
- Although they have a variety of magazines, you may wish to bring reading material of your own.
- Bring \$1 bills to use the vending machines! The change machine will not break bigger than \$5.

## ONE STOP Day 1: Show up as early as 1pm, but NO LATER THAN 4:50pm to take the ASVAB. If you show up after that time, you will be turned away.

After you complete the physical, you will be shuttled to (or can drive yourself to) the Hotel and use the same mode of transportation back to MEPS in the morning. (ie. If you take your car to the hotel and then ride the shuttle in the morning, you will not have a ride back to the hotel when you are done processing. )

## Day 2: Show up NLT 5:50am to complete the enlistment physical.

If you complete the physical with enough time to meet with your recruiter, you can job search the same day.

## MEPS LOCATION

The Military Entrance Processing Station is where you take the ASVAB and Physical that are required to join the military. You get an appointment set up through your recruiter. MEPS is located on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Bishop Henry Whipple Federal Building 1 Federal Drive, Saint Paul, MN 55111 (Across the street from the 133<sup>rd</sup>)

## MEPS HOTEL

There is a hotel you can stay at the night prior to your processing. MEPS will schedule the hotel for you at no cost to you. Doubletree by Hilton Bloomington, 7800 Normandale Blvd, Bloomington MN 55439.

## SAME DAY PROCESSING (Needs to be scheduled well in advance)

Your processing begins at 6:00 am. The completion time varies. Depending on the number of applicants, you may get done as early as 12:00 pm, but normally it is completed by 2:00 pm.

## ASVAB ONLY

For applicants who are only taking the ASVAB test, work with your recruiter to schedule the day you want to test. On your scheduled test date, you can arrive at MEPS anytime between 7am-3pm or 7am-1pm on the last day of the week (typically Friday). The ASVAB takes approx. 3 hours to administer, but there is check-in etc.
